Pool Rental Rules and Regulations
Updated 4-24-10

General Pool Rules

- A. Lifeguards are the ULTIMATE authority concerning pool safety
- B. Anyone (including adults) disobeying the rules, ignoring the lifeguard's instruction or endangering the safety of any other person will be asked to leave the pool area. Repeat violator may result in suspension of pool privileges for up to the remainder of season.
- C. All members will sign in at the entry gate. Each family will be required presenting their pool pass to the lifeguard upon entering. This procedure will be strictly enforced. Please pick up your pass upon departing, DO NOT leave your pass in the box.
- D. ALL guests will need to be signed in at the entry gate by their sponsoring member. No more than four guests will be allowed per pool pass. Any guest above four will be required to contact a board member to rent the pool after resident hours. There is no exception to this rule.
- E. Parties are not allowed in the pool area, decorations, etc are not allowed in the pool during normal hours. Private pool parties must be outside the residential hours.
- F. No running allowed in pool area.
- G. No excessive horse play in pool area.
- H. No diving whatsoever. Flips or inward dives are prohibited for the sides of pool.
- I. No glass containers of any kind in the pool area.
- J. No alcohol allowed in pool area.
- K. No smoking allowed in pool area.
- L. No profanity of any kind will be allowed in pool area.
- M. Abusive language or gestures by anyone in the pool area will result in expulsion for the pool by the lifeguards.
- N. Fighting in and around the pool area will not be tolerated. Violators are subject to suspension of pool privileges.
- O. No pets in the pool area
- P. **No cutoffs or street clothes** are allowed in pool area.
- Q. No pushing anyone into the pool.
- R. Adults have priority for use of chaise lounges deck chairs and tables.
- S. Use of flotation devices/toys will be the discretion of the lifeguards. Size and number of devices will be based on the number of patrons in the pool. This includes any water/bath toys, nerf balls, squirt guns, rafts, tubes, noodles, kick boards and any other toys. Zodiac Boats and surfboards and other large toy/flotation devices will not be allowed.

- T. If the behavior of a swimmer using any water toy endangers the safety of others, the offending swimmer will be asked by the lifeguard to remove the toy from the pool. Failure to comply will result in the expulsion from the pool.
- U. Any persons infected with a communicable disease are restricted from entering the swimming pool and or baby wading pool.
- V. All persons must shower off before entering pool. All sunbathers using suntan lotions and or oils must shower off before entering the pool. All persons must shower off after using the restroom facilities.
- W. ONE LONG WHISTLE BLAST means to clear the pool immediately. (EMERGENCY or DANGER)
- X. All swimmer sunder 10 years of age and Non –Swimmers under the age of 14 must be accompanied by a responsible adult over the age of 18.
- Y. All guests are subject to a swim test at the discretion of the lifeguard.
- Z. Diving mask fins and snorkels are allowed in the pool provided the swimmer has sufficient knowledge to use the equipment safely. If the lifeguard identifies a swimmer using the equipment improperly or unsafely, the equipment will be removed from the pool.
- AA. If requested, one swim lane will be designated for lap swimming only. No swimmer may swim into or across the lap lane.
- BB. Swimmers must stay on other side of rope designated for slide dispatch area; the swimmers are also not allowed to hang on to the rope.

Ten Minute Break

- A. When the outside temperate is above 85 degrees, an hour's break of 10 minutes is mandatory. If it is under 85 degrees than it is at the lifeguards discretion.
- B. During break, all swimmers under 18 years of age must be out of the pool. Only parents or guardians over the age of 18 may accompany small children under 5 years of age and non swimmers into the pool during this time.
- C. The purpose of this policy is to reduce the number of heat exhaustion in young swimmers while in the pool.

Baby Pool Rules

- A. **Lifeguards are NOT assigned to supervise the baby pool.** Parents and/or guardians are responsible for their children while using the baby pool.
- B. Parents or guardians must accompany their children into and out of the baby pool. You will be asked to leave if you do not supervise your children.
- C. Only non swimming children 5 years and under are allowed in the baby pool other than parents or guardians.
- D. Minimum age to supervise a child in the baby pool is 14 years old.
- E. All pool rules apply to the baby pool.
- F. Swimwear is required.
- G. **Disposables diapers are not allowed in either pool. Swim diapers or rubber pants are required. Failure to have these items your child will not be allowed in pool.**

Pool Slide Rules

- A. Guest must be at least 42" tall to participate unless assisted at dispatch area by an adult 18 or older.
- B. Swimwear with metal snaps, buttons, zippers, and other hard fasteners are not allowed.
- C. Eyeglasses, sunglasses and jewelry are prohibited.
- D. Only one guest on slide at a time, no tandem sliding allowed.
- E. Guest must immediately exit the dispatch areas upon entering the water.
- F. Guest wear flotation devices are not allowed on the slide.
- G. Any type of horseplay will not be tolerated.
- H. Stopping on slide is not allowed.
- I. All guests are required to ride slide on their back sides, feet first

Private Parties

- A. The pool may be rented for private parties by residents in good standings, provided such parties are not during normal pool hours.
- B. Private parties can be held up to 2 hours before the pool opens or up to 2 hours after pool closes. The minimum amount of time required to rent the pool is 2 hours. No pool parties after 10:00 pm will be allowed.
- C. Maximum capacity is 50 people
- D. Residents who wish to rent the pool for private party will do so by contact a HOA committee member to schedule the use. This should be done at least 2 weeks in advance and is on a first come first serve basis. The pool rental does not include the park or clubhouse.
- E. A cash deposit of \$100.00 is required to be paid to the HOA committee member when the agreement for rental of the pool is signed. A 50.00 rental fee will also be required at the time of rental. The HOA committee member will be responsible for contact the pool management company to schedule a minimum of 2 lifeguards for the event. The minimum amount for lifeguards is 35.00 per hours for 2 guards an additional \$18.00 an hour for additional guards. Number of guards will be determined by Jeff King with Aqua Rec. A minimum of two lifeguards for a minimum two hour rental. The renter will make the payment for the lifeguards 24 hours before the day of the event. A HOA committee member will verify with the pool management company that the pool area was cleaned after the party. The lifeguards do not clean up after the party. This is the responsibility of the renter, not the lifeguards. If no, all or portion of the deposit will be withheld.
- F. All trash should be taken home with the renter and NOT left at the pool clubhouse area.
- G. For parties held after normal pool hours, attendees will not be allowed in the pool area until 8:00 pm, nor will set up be allowed before 8:00 pm.

- H. Renter may be allowed access to the pool is at 7:45 depending on the number of residents in the pool area.
- I. If pool is rented for a function at which alcohol is present or served, the renter will be responsible for securing TWO uniformed peace officers to be present for the entire party. Proof of hiring peace officers must be provided to a committee member before the party can commence.
